## Frequently Asked Questions

What are the dates and times of The 203 Project: A Sustainable Showhouse at the Darien Community Association Presented by CTC&G? The Showhouse is open from 6pm-9pm on Thursday (3/21), 10am-4pm on Friday (3/22) & Saturday (3/23), and 11am-2pm on Sunday (3/24). The last entry is 30 minutes prior to closing time. Tickets are sold out for some events. Please visit dariendca.org.

**How much does the Showhouse cost to attend?** Ticket prices vary based on the event date and time. Tickets range in price from \$40 - \$120. There is also pricing available exclusively for DCA members.

**How do I become a DCA member?** Visit the DCA website: <a href="www.dariendca.org">www.dariendca.org</a> and click "Become a Member." Follow directions to set up your membership credentials. You must sign in to your membership account when registering for Showhouse events to access membership pricing.

How do I get to the Showhouse and is there space to park? The Darien Community Association is located at 274 Middlesex Road in Darien CT. Parking is available. Please be patient, drive slowly as you watch for pedestrians, plan for ample time to find a parking spot and follow the directions of the Darien Police Officers on site. Keep the driveways clear for emergency and delivery vehicles to enter and exit the property. Please do not park on the side streets of the residential neighborhood.

## I am interested in buying a ticket for the Showhouse.

- Please visit the DCA website at dariendca.org to purchase tickets to the Showhouse. Depending on availability, a limited number of tickets may be purchased at the door. The last entry is 30 minutes prior to closing time.
- Tickets can only be used on the day/time that you have selected. Please read event descriptions carefully.
- Tickets are non-refundable but tickets are transferable. Please email
  info@dariendca.org if you need to transfer your ticket to a friend. Indicate your
  name and the name of the person who will be using the ticket.
- Children are welcome to the Sunday Jazz Brunch. Children are not invited to other Showhouse events. Our rooms cannot accommodate strollers during the Showhouse. Service animals are welcome.

**I bought a ticket.** Upon arrival at the Showhouse, you must check in at the registration table. Every ticket purchased is date and time specific. Attendees are allowed to enter the house at any time during each time session window, but need to exit by the conclusion of the session.

**What comes with my ticket?** Enjoy a self-guided tour of the beautiful Showhouse and an informative digital program. Mingle with friends, designers, artists and DCA members as you nibble on light bites and coffee or lunch depending on your event.

How do I know my ticket transaction was completed successfully? All registrants will receive an email confirmation from the Darien Community Association upon ticket purchase. Please type in your email address carefully and check your spam and junk folders.

Where is the nearest public transit? The Darien Community Association is a short ride from the Darien and Noroton Heights train stations (Metro North). Uber and taxis services are available.

**Is there a dress code?** Come as you are; you look great! Leave the heels at home and enjoy yourself!

**How long will it take to tour the Showhouse?** At a leisurely pace, the self-guided tour will take approximately an hour.

**Are bathrooms available for Showhouse guests?** Yes. Accessible bathrooms are available for attendees.
